The Teen Health Outreach project combines adventure-based programming, leadership and decision-making skills, and adolescent sexual health information to create an adventure that won't soon be forgotten!

This program is part of the Wake County 4-H Youth Leaders in Action Academy, which is a gang prevention initiative funded by the John Rex Foundation.

Program Sites: Raleigh (Millbrook Area) and Eastern Wake County

Program Dates: Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday evenings 4-8PM*

Program begins June 16th and concludes August 20th

**Dates/times for trips may vary; parents notified in advance of schedule.*

Ages: High school youth. **Out-of-school youth are encouraged to apply.**

Cost: There is no charge to attend this program.

Criteria: Youth must be healthy enough to participate in adventure-based programming such as sailing, low and high ropes, horseback riding, and hiking. Youth must be mature enough to handle comprehensive information regarding adolescent sexual health. Transportation to and from the program sites is not provided, except for field trips. Meals are not provided during non-field trip days. *This is a gang prevention initiative that seeks to engage youth at high risk for joining gangs.*

To Apply: Applications are required for any youth wishing to participate. Home visits will be scheduled with participants meeting selection criteria. **Space is limited, so it is encouraged that youth apply early.** Deadline is May 15th, 2009 at 5PM.
