Friday, all students taking AP exams will receive a memo through their first period teacher. This memo includes preadministration session information as well as testing location information. Please encourage your son or daughter to carefully review this information. Because some AP exams are off campus this year, parent permission is required for students to ride with another student or drive another student to the site. The permission form is attached to the AP exam memo and must be returned no later than April 30.

Any student who has registered for an AP course next year is required to complete an AP contract. Those students who have not submitted their contract is being notified through advisory on Friday. Failing to complete a contract would mean being withdrawn from the course.

If you have a Junior who is considering applying for the Teaching Fellows scholarship next school year, please encourage them to take the SAT prior to the end of this academic year. This is a four-year, full tuition scholarship to encourage more interest in education. Go to www.teachingfellows.org for more details.
